Paints

Option 1: Brittney Tough Warm & Cool Essentials Palette (6 colours-minimum colours for this course)

Option 2: Brittney Tough Full Colour Palette (12 colours- the full range, but not necessary)

If you already have watercolour paints, please bring professional quality paint brands. For this course, you will need a minimum of 2 different yellows, 2 different reds, and 2 different blues. Please come with a variety of temperatures, for example, a warm red, blue and yellow and cool red, blue and yellow. Below are some suggested colours.

- Lemon Yellow or Hansa Yellow Light
- Aureolin or Hansa Yellow
- India Yellow or Hansa Yellow deep
- Pyrrole Red or Carmine
- Permanent Alizarin Crimson or Quinacridone Red Indanthrone or Ultramarine Blue
- Phthalo Blue or Prussian

Brushes

I use two or three round watercolor brushes (small, medium, and large) made with a blend of synthetic and natural hair. Suggested professional brushes: Rosemary & Co. Sable Blend Series 401, sizes 4, 8, 14, or 20. For student-grade brushes, Taklon or Princeton brushes are suitable. Choose two or three round brushes in small, medium, and large sizes, such as 4, 8, and 12.

Paper

Two 1/8 sheet of Arches 140 lb or 300 lb cold-pressed rough watercolor paper, approximately 11 × 7 inches.

Extra watercolour scraps for testing colour

Extras

- Large palette for mixing colors (a flat palette is preferred, but use what is comfortable)
- Kleenex and paper towels
- Water bucket
- Masking tape
- Drawing board, or another rigid surface to tape the paper to, approximately 11 × 14 inches
- Pencil and eraser (H or 2H graphite preferred)
- Eyedropper or nasal aspirator
- Blow dryer
